### FOOD VENDOR FEES Per Food Booth:

- \$500.00 flat fee for all five days of the fair August 5 – August 9, 2026 (Includes Electricity)  
**Add \$75.00 Electrician Fee to be hard wired into electrical panel**
- \$25.00/day Campsite Fee (includes water, sewer hookup and electricity)
- Vendors will receive 2 week passes per paid booth space

All Vendors must supply the Fair with a Certificate of Insurance naming the Northern Maine Fair Association as **ADDITIONAL INSURED** for the duration of the fair including setup and breakdown August 5– August 9, 2026. (Insurance Certificates are due prior to your arrival on the fairgrounds)
